Peoples Gas System ("PGS"), by its undersigned attorneys, submits the following Preliminary List of Issues and Positions:

### Generic Purchased Gas Adjustment Issues

ISSUE 1: What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2012 through December 2012?

PGS: \$407,897 over-recovery

ISSUE 2: What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

PGS: \$400,660 under-recovery

ISSUE 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2014 through December 2014?

PGS: \$7,240 over-recovery

ISSUE 4: What are the levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2014 through December 2014?

PGS: \$0.91848 per therm

ISSUE 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

<u>PGS</u>: The charge should be effective beginning with the specified purchased gas cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2014 through December 2014. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2014, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2014, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment charge became effective.
