Item Number 2 addresses PRH-2600 Hallandale Beach's petition for variance from or waiver of Rule 25-6.049(5) and (6), *Florida Administrative Code*.

Rule 25-6.049(5) states that condominiums must be individually metered, and subsection (6) of the rule requires that if they wish to be master metered, condominiums must attest that they satisfy the three criteria in subsection (5).

PRH, the developer of Beachwalk Condominium, seeks a rule waiver so that Beachwalk Condominium may be master metered. The petition demonstrates that Beachwalk Condominium will operate as a hotel. PRH has shown that without the waiver, Beachwalk Condominium will be treated differently from other hotels and will

be placed at a competitive disadvantage. PRH has also demonstrated that master metering Beachwalk Condominium will conserve energy.

For these reasons, we recommend that the rule waiver be granted with the conditions that Beachwalk Condominium reasonably apportion the cost of electricity. The waiver is only effective while Beachwalk Condominium operates as a hotel, and Beachwalk Condominium will be responsible for the cost of any conversion to individual metering.

Staff is available to address any questions you may have.
