FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Pursuant to section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby submits this Request for Confidential Classification of Appendix B to FPL and the Peace River Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s ("PRECO'S") Joint Petition for Approval of Territorial Agreement, and in support states:

1. On October 23, 2013, FPL and PRECO submitted Florida Power & Light Company and the Peace River Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s Joint Petition for Approval of Transfer of Customers ("Petition"). Separately, on the same date, FPL submitted a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of Exhibit B to the Petition, along with a confidential copy of Exhibit B. The original Exhibit B submitted on October 23, 2013, inadvertently included confidential information which should have been redacted. On October 24, 2013, FPL submitted a revised version of Exhibit B in redacted form and requested the return of the original Exhibit B. On October 28, 2013, the Commission returned the original Exhibit B to FPL. On November 8, 2013, FPL identified errors in the revised Exhibit B submitted on October 24, 2013. FPL submitted a redacted corrected second revised version of Exhibit B.

2. Exhibit B contains an identification of customers who will be transferred as a result of the Petition. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, FPL is filing this Request for Confidential Classification.

2. The following exhibits are included with, and made a part of, this request:

(a) Exhibit A is an unredacted copy of the documents for which FPL seeks confidential treatment. Exhibit A is being submitted separately in a sealed envelope labeled "CONFIDENTIAL." In the unredacted version, the information asserted to be confidential is highlighted in yellow.

(b) Exhibit B contains two copies of a redacted version of the documents for which FPL requests confidential classification. The specific information for which confidential treatment is requested has been redacted.

(c) Exhibit C is a table that identifies the information for which FPL seeks confidential classification and the specific statutory bases for seeking confidential treatment; and

(d) Exhibit D consists of the affidavits of David T. Bromley of FPL andRandall W. Shaw of PRECO in support of this request.

4. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL and PRECO as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determined that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the hard of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

5. As indicated in Mr. Bromley's affidavit that is included in Exhibit D, the information that FPL asserts is proprietary and confidential business information is customer-specific account information with respect to non-governmental customers. FPL has a corporate

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policy not to disclose customer specific information. This policy includes, but is not limited to: customer names, addresses, telephone numbers, account numbers, rates, billing determinants (kW and kWh usage), conservation savings in kW, kWh and bills. FPL treats such information as confidential and does not disclose it, except as required by law, to entities or persons other than the customer without the permission of the customer. FPL's policy is premised upon customers' right to privacy and the potential that the disclosure of customer specific information may harm some customers' competitive interests. Such information is protected from public disclosure pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

6. As further indicated in Randall W. Shaw's affidavit that is included in Exhibit D, the information that FPL asserts is proprietary and confidential business information, on behalf of PRECO, is PRECO customer-specific account information. PRECO has a policy not to disclose customer specific information. This policy includes, but is not limited to: customer names, addresses, telephone numbers, account numbers, rates, billing determinants (kW and kWh usage), conservation savings in kW, kWh and bills. PRECO treats such information as confidential and does not disclose it, except as required by law, to entities or persons other than the customer without the permission of the customer. PRECO's policy is based upon the customer's right to privacy and the potential that the disclosure of the customer specific information may harm some customers' competitive interests. Such information is protected from public disclosure pursuant to 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

7. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information provided in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibits B, C and D is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be

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returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See S.366.093(4)*, F.S.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the material described herein.
