**Issue 1:** Should the Commission approve the Utility's amended request for a limited proceeding rate increase? **Recommendation:** The Commission should approve in part and deny in part the Utility's requested rate increase. Peoples should provide proof that the customers have received notice within 10 days after the date of the notice.
