On December 4, 2013, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 07268-13. This document contains information regarding the costs of information system changes associated with the implementation of the optional non-standard meter rider. The information for which FPL seeks confidential treatment relates to specific out-sourced contractors and their respective budgeted dollar amounts. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with FPL that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm utility customers' competitive business operations.

Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's request for confidential classification of Document No. 07268-13 be approved.
