Yes, those monies were received as contemplated by the Settlement Agreement.

Has Forest commenced the work referenced in ¶4.2 necessary to meet the Flow Requirements? If so, what date was the work commenced?; if not, when do you anticipate that this work will begin?

Forest commenced the design work immediately after the execution of the Settlement Agreement. Forest commenced the permitting on approximately November 25, 2013. Work on the project has not yet commenced. Forest deems it prudent to wait until approval of the extension by the Commission before moving forward with the expense of construction as contemplated by the Settlement Agreement within Jamaica Bay West. Accordingly, work should begin very soon after the Commission order is issued.

If work has commenced, have you received the \$250,000 payment from Jamaica Bay required by ¶4.2? See above response. The \$250,000 payment from Jamaica Bay West required by ¶4.2 has not yet been received.
