Dear Mr. Smallridge:

The above referenced application has been received and reviewed by Commission staff. Staff previously noted several deficiencies in a letter dated April 18, 2013, and requested a response by May 17, 2013. Staff has received two requests for an additional 30 days to respond, filed on June 3, 2013, and July 22, 2013, respectively. As of the date of this letter, the deficiencies outlined below have not been addressed. Please complete the following deficiencies and provide the requested additional information to clarify the application.

Deficiencies

- 1) Public Interest. Rule 25-30.037(2)(j), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), requires a statement indicating how the transfer is in the public interest, including a summary of the buyer's experience in water or wastewater utility operations, a showing of the buyer's financial ability to provide service, and a statement that the buyer will fulfill the commitments, obligations and representations of the seller with regard to utility matters. Please provide a statement attesting to the above-mentioned issues, including a description of any repairs, upgrades, or improvements made to the utility's facilities or operations while serving as the court-appointed Receiver and since becoming owner.
- 2) Sample Tariff. Rule 25-30.037(2)(s), F.A.C., requires that the applicant file the original and two copies of sample tariff sheets reflecting the change in ownership. The utility will need to update all pages in its wastewater tariff to reflect the change in ownership if the transfer application is approved. Please provide an original and two copies of sample tariff sheets reflecting the utility's new name; issuing officer's name and title; existing rates and charges; and wastewater service territory description. While sample tariff sheets are sufficient pending completion of the Commission's review of this docket, the utility is not precluded from submitting a complete tariff at this time if preferred.

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- **3) Ownership of the Land**. Rule 25-30.037(2)(q), F.A.C., requires evidence that the utility owns the land upon which the utility treatment facilities are located, or a copy of an agreement which provides for the continued use of the land, such as a 99-year lease. The application indicates that pursuant to a court order, West Lakeland Wastewater, LLC (West Lakeland or Utility) was granted ownership of the land upon which the wastewater treatment plant is located. However, the application does not include proof of ownership or long-term use of the land upon which the percolation ponds and sprayfields are located. Please provide evidence that the buyer now owns or has long-term use of that land. If the buyer has not yet obtained a warranty deed, long-term lease, or easement to the land upon which the percolation ponds and sprayfields are located provide to secure long-term use of that land.
- 4) Application Fee. Rule 25-30.020(2)(c), F.A.C., requires that an application fee be paid for an application for authority to transfer filed pursuant to Section 367.071, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Staff has determined that an application fee of \$750 is due for this application. Please remit your payment to the Commission's Division of Administrative and IT Services, referencing the docket number.
- 5) Notice of Application and Legal Description. Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.030, F.A.C., require the utility to provide notice of its application for transfer. The legal description was not included in the application. Staff suggests that the utility use the following previously approved legal description.

The following described lands located in portions of Sections 14 and 23, Township 28 South, Range 24 East, Pasco County, Florida.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 14, Township 28 South, Range 24 East; run thence East along the South boundary of said Section 14 to the Southeast corner of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 14; thence North to the Northwest corner of the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 14; thence East to the Northeast corner of said South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4; thence South along the East boundary of the West 1/2 of said Section 14 and the East boundary of the West 1/2 of Section 23 of said Township and Range to the Southeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 23; thence East to the Northeast corner of the West 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 23; thence South to the Southeast corner of said West 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4; thence West along the South boundary of said Section 23 to a point 220 feet West of the Southeast corner of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 23; thence North 1247.05 feet, West 100 feet, North 600 feet, West 180 feet, North 500 feet, West to the West boundary of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 23; thence North along said West boundary of said East 1/2 of said Southwest 1/4 and along the West boundary of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 23 to the Northwest corner of said Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4; thence West along the South boundary of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 23 to the West boundary of said

Section 23; thence North along said West boundary to the point of beginning. All in Sections 14 and 23, Township 28 South, Range 24 East.

A sample notice (Attachment A) and list of parties to be noticed (Attachment B) is attached for your reference. Please feel free to provide a draft notice to staff to review prior to mailing in order to ensure that the notice complies with the Commission's noticing rules. Upon completion of the noticing requirements, please provide the three required affidavits of noticing referenced as late-filed Exhibits 7 through 9 in the utility's application.

Additional Information

- 1) Purchase Price. Rule 25-30.037(2)(g)(1.), F.A.C., requires a copy of the contract for sale, which shall include, if applicable, the purchase price. Although the transfer of ownership to West Lakeland by the court did not include a traditional purchase price, the Commission may consider other forms of financial investment in the utility in lieu of a purchase price. If applicable, please provide a list of and dollar amount of any personal investments the buyer made in the utility facilities or operations while serving as the court-appointed Receiver, such as payments for repairs, upgrades, or other expenses made with personal funds rather than utility revenue, or personal loans to the utility.
- 2) List of Assets and Liabilities Assumed. Rule 25-30.037(2)(g)(2.), F.A.C., requires a copy of the contract for sale, which shall include, if applicable, a list of and the dollar amount of the assets purchased and liabilities assumed or not assumed, including those of nonregulated operations or entities. Referencing Exhibit A of the court order provided in the utility's application,¹ please provide a more detailed list of and the dollar amount of the assets and liabilities assumed if possible.

The **original and four copies** of the response to the information requested in this letter should be filed with the Commission on or before **February 28, 2014**. If additional time is required for one or more deficiencies, in your response, please identify these deficiencies and the anticipated amount of time required to resolve them.
