**Docket No. 130288-WS** – Request for approval of late payment charge in Brevard County by Aquarina Utilities, Inc.

**Issue 1:** Should Aquarina's request to implement a \$7.00 late payment charge be approved?

**Recommendation:** Yes. Aquarina's request to implement a \$7.00 late payment charge should be approved. Aquarina should be required to file a proposed customer notice to reflect the Commission-approved charge. The approved charge should be effective for services rendered on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheet, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475(1), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). In addition, the approved charge should not be implemented until staff has approved the proposed customer notice. The Utility should provide proof of the date notice was given no less than ten days after the date of the notice.



**Issue 2:** Should this docket be closed?

**Recommendation:** ~~Yes~~<sup>Yes</sup> If Issue 1 is approved, the docket should remain open for staff's verification that the revised tariff sheet and customer notice have been filed by the Utility and approved by staff. The revised tariff sheet should become effective on or after the stamped approval date on the revised tariff sheet, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, F.A.C. If a protest is filed within 21 days of the issuance date of the Order, the tariff should remain in effect with all late payment charges held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest, and the docket should remain open. If no timely protest is filed, a consummating order should be issued and, once staff verifies that the notice of the late payment charge has been given to customers, the docket should be administratively closed.
