Good morning everyone. For clarification purposes, I'm responding to this e-mail rather than a later one to me from atty Sayler and Ms. Davis in his office. OPC will need to e-file the documents for the third time.

Mr. Sayler is correct that that one of the reasons the four filings were rejected on Friday, March 7th, was that there was no signature and no cover page with instructions to the Clerk's Office advising what was to be done with the information. Several of them said, "correspondence" Correspondence is not eligible for e-filing.

After the e-filings were rejected, someone called from OPC (I'm sorry, I did not get the name of the caller) and spoke with Crystal in our office for clarification as to why the e-filings were rejected. In an abundance of caution, I called atty Barrera and asked if she knew what was to be done with the documents if they were filed with CLK again, as they appeared to be correspondence. Ms. Barrera advised that she had filed the information that atty Sayler was attempting to e-file (see DN 01085-14) and that they should be returned, with instructions to call atty Barrera directly if there were any questions. Three of the four documents were e-filed again on Monday, March 10th, with a cover letter, and per atty Barrera's instruction were rejected.

In the meantime, atty Sayler spoke with atty Barrera and advised that some of the information being e-filed was different than what she had filed. Atty Barrera then contacted me to advise that atty Sayler would be filing them again (a third time). We received them by cc to an e-mail this morning, however, e-mails are not an accepted form of filing, so they will need to be correctly e-filed through the web portal or by e-mail to [filings@psc.state.fl.us](mailto:filings@psc.state.fl.us) to be considered e-filed.


