 <u>Cleaning Service & Laundromat</u>: Commercial Cleaning Service and Laundromat customers are defined as establishments primarily engaged in operating mechanical laundries with steam or other power. Establishments primarily engaged in supplying laundered work clothing on a contract or fee basis
