Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0143 (1) (m) F.A.C., Gulf Power Company files this report providing information concerning efforts to obtain commercial insurance for transmission and distribution (T&D) facilities and a summary of amounts recorded in Account 228.1.

- Status of Other Efforts to Obtain Commercial T&D Insurance The property insurance markets remain very restrictive, especially for Gulf of Mexico coastal locations. Based on recent discussions with property insurance brokers and underwriters, property insurance coverage for Gulf Power's T&D facilities is not available at reasonable cost and deductible levels.
- 2. <u>Summary</u> Gulf Power accrued \$3,500,000 to Account 228.1 during January through December 2013. In addition, earnings on the fund reserve of \$26,140 were booked to the account. The December 31, 2013 balance was \$35,380,305.
