TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S REPORT ON STATUS OF TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN TAMPA ELECTRIC <u>COMPANY AND THE CITY OF LAKELAND</u>

In Order No. PSC-92-0570-FOF-EU issued on June 25, 1992 in Docket No. 920251-EU the Commission approved the territorial agreement entered into by and between Tampa Electric Company and the City of Lakeland, Florida. Section 4.1 of said agreement calls for an annual report from Tampa Electric Company providing the status of the agreement and any modifications proposed in the agreement.

On March 18, 2014 Tampa Electric and the City of Lakeland filed a joint petition seeking the Commission's approval of a second amendment to their territorial agreement which makes some minor modifications to the territorial boundary between the two utilities to better enable them to provide electric service to their respective customers in the future. As the joint petition explains, no current customers of either utility will be affected by the proposed territorial boundary modifications. The joint petition has been assigned No. 140054-EU and remains pending. Aside from the modifications proposed in the second amendment, the agreement remains in full force and effect.

The parties will advise the Commission to the extent that any changes are proposed and will petition the Commission to resolve any disputes which may arise concerning the provisions of the agreement which the parties are unable to resolve.
