Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light requests to extend for 18 months the confidential classification of highlighted information produced in response to staff's 6th request for PODs (No. 50). (FPL's First Request For Extension of Confidential Classification is Document No. 02340-14, and the confidential document is 02341-14.)

On September 12, 1012, FPL filed its original Request for Confidential Classification. By Order No. PSC-12-0625-CFO-EI, issued November 20, 2012, the Commission granted FPL's original request.

Staff has reviewed FPL's request to extend for 18 months the confidential classification of highlighted information produced in response to staff's 6th request for PODs (No. 50). In staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request to extend the confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 02341-14 be approved.
