The submission contains information provided in response to Intervenor Martin et al.'s Amended First Set of Interrogatories, Nos. 24 and 37 in the subject docket. In the document materials, the information for which FPL seeks confidential treatment relates to information concerning bids or other contractual data and information relating to competitive interests.
