FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC") hereby submits this preliminary statement of issues and positions:

GENERIC CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY ISSUES

ISSUE 1:	What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period			
January 2013 through December 2013?				

<u>FPUC:</u> The Company under-recovered \$292,961, resulting in a final end of period true-up amount of \$82,299.

<u>ISSUE 2</u>: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2015 through December 2015?

FPUC: FPUC seeks to recover \$688,627 over the period January 2015 through December 2015.

ISSUE 3: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2015 through December 2015?

FPUC: The Company asks for approval of a consolidated levelized conservation cost recovery factor for this period of \$.00107 per KWH.

ISSUE 4: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

FPUC: The factor should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2015 through December 2015. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2015 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2015, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.
