Florida City Gas: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2015 through December 2015. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2015 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2015, so that

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each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.
