On September 30, 2014, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 05521-14. This document is Exhibit A to a firm transportation service agreement between Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula) and FPUC. The information in the document for which FPUC seeks confidential treatment relates to the maximum daily transportation quantity (MDTQ) and the monthly reservation charge. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with FPUC that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm FPUC's competitive business operations.

Therefore, staff recommends that FPUC's request for confidential classification of Document No. 05521-14 be approved.
