This is the 2014 clause prehearing conferences for the following dockets: 140002-EG, 140003-GU, 140004-GU, 140007-EI, and 140001-EI. I would like to call this prehearing to order.

Staff, can you please read the notice for this proceeding.

MS. TAN: By notice issued September 17th, 2014, this time and place is set for a prehearing conference in the following dockets: 140001-EI, 140002-EG, 140003-GU, 140004-GU, and 140007-EI. The purpose of the prehearing conference is set out in the notice.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you so much.

There are five dockets to address today. Staff suggests that appearances be taken up all at once, so all parties should enter their appearances and declare the dockets that they are entering an appearance for, although I do recognize that several parties will be making appearances for more than one docket.

After the parties have made their appearances, staff will make their appearance as a whole. Starting

Appearance for John Butler, Ken Rubin in the 02 docket, and John Butler, Wade Litchfield, and Maria Moncada in the 07 docket. Thank you.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay.

MR. BEASLEY: Good afternoon, Commissioner. James D. Beasley appearing with J. Jeffry Wahlen, Ashley M. Daniels, all of the law firm of Ausley & McMullen, on behalf of Tampa Electric Company in the 01, the 02, and the 07 dockets.

TAN: Lee Eng Tan on behalf of the 02 docket, Kyesha Mapp and Keino Young on the 03 docket, 4 Kelley Corbari on the 04 docket, Charles Murphy on the 5 07 docket, and Martha Barrera on the 01 docket. Thank 6 7 you. 8 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you so much. 9 Mary Anne. 10 MS. HELTON: And Mary Anne Helton, I'm here as your advisor in all the dockets. 11 12 13 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Moving to Docket 140004. 14 Ms. Corbari. MS. CORBARI: Good afternoon, Commissioner. 15 Staff would like to note for the record that St. Joe 16 17 Natural Gas Company and Peoples Gas System, 18 Incorporated, have requested and received permission to 19 be excused from attending the prehearing and hearing in 20 the 04 docket. Staff is not aware of any other 21 preliminary matters at this time and none are expected. 22 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. We are, as I 23 stated earlier, we're going to go through similarly the draft Prehearing Order pretty swiftly. So please speak 24 25 up.

000008 I'm going to start with Section I, the case 1 background. Any changes or comments? Seeing none. 2 3 Section II, conduct of proceedings. None. Section III, jurisdiction. Seeing none. 4 5 Section IV, procedure for handing confidential information. Seeing no changes. 6 7 Section V, prefiled testimony, exhibits, and witnesses. Seeing no changes. 8 9 Section VI, order of witnesses. Staff? MS. CORBARI: Staff notes that page 4 of the 10 draft Prehearing Order states that witnesses may be 11 12 excused if no Commissioner seeks cross-examination. Looking at the positions the parties have taken in this 13 14 docket, staff is hopeful that a stipulation will be reached on all the issues with the witnesses excused and 15 testimony and exhibits included in the record. Staff is 16 17 going to continue working towards this. 18 COMMISSIONER BROWN: That's great. 19 MS. CORBARI: We are close. COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you very much for 20 21 pointing that out, too. 22 Section VII, we're going to basic positions. 23 Ms. -- hi. OPC. 24 MS. CHRISTENSEN: Patty Christensen with OPC. 25 We would change our basic position from none at this

time to just none, period. Thank you.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. Any other parties?

Okay. Section VIII, issues and positions, staff.

MS. CORBARI: Staff notes that the Order Establishing Procedure requires a party to take a position at the prehearing conference unless good cause is shown as to why that party cannot take a position at this time. Accordingly, if a party's position in the draft Prehearing Order is currently no position at that time -- at this time, the party must change its position or show good cause why it cannot take a position. Staff would suggest the parties who have not taken a position or wish to change their position be permitted to submit their position in writing by close of business tomorrow, October 9th. If a party fails to take a position by that time, the Prehearing Order will reflect no position for such.

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COMMISSIONER BROWN: Ms. Christensen.

MS. CHRISTENSEN: Thank you. At this time OPC would change our positions from no position at this time to no position. And based on that, we would also be amenable to just taking no position on any Type 2 stipulations.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Duly noted. Any other parties?

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MR. HORTON: Commissioner, with respect to Sebring Gas, on Issue 3 we would concur with the staff's factor shown there, and that's reflected in Section X already.

> **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Okay. Thank you. Noted. Any other parties? Okay.

MS. CORBARI: Commissioner, staff would like to add that it appears that all issues are ripe for stipulation with OPC taking no position on all the issues.

With respect to Issue 5, staff is currently finalizing its position. However, it appears as though staff and the consolidated companies have reached a stipulation on the issue, again with OPC taking no position. Staff's revised position on Issue 5 will be submitted to the parties by close of business tomorrow, if not sooner.

20 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. Thank you
21 very much.

Section IX -- I'm sorry. Yeah. Section IX, exhibit list.

MS. CORBARI: Staff has prepared a draft comprehensive exhibit list which includes all prefiled

exhibits and any exhibits staff wishes to include in the record. Staff will circulate the draft to the parties tomorrow to determine if there's any objections to the draft comprehensive exhibit list.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Section X, proposed stipulations.

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MS. CORBARI: Again it appears that all issues are ripe for stipulation. With respect to Issue 5, staff is currently finalizing its position. However, it appears that a stipulation has been reached with the consolidated companies, and staff's revised position on Issue 5 will be submitted to the parties by close of business tomorrow.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. Moving along, unless there's any additional stipulations, Section XI, pending motions.

MS. CORBARI: There are no pending motions.COMMISSIONER BROWN: XII, confidentiality.MS. CORBARI: There are none.COMMISSIONER BROWN: Good job.

MS. CORBARI: If the parties agree to waive briefs, the Commission may make a bench decision for this portion of the docket. If there any issues to be briefed, staff recommends that post-hearing briefs be no

000012 longer than 20 pages. In addition, staff notes that any 1 briefs will be due on November 5th for the December 16th 2 3 agenda conference. COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. 4 Section XIV, rulings. 5 MS. CORBARI: Staff would recommend that 6 7 opening statements, if any, shall be limited to five minutes, unless the parties choose to waive opening 8 9 statements, and briefs be limited to 20 pages. COMMISSIONER BROWN: And -- thank you. 10 11 MS. CORBARI: And staff also notes the 12 St. Joe Natural Gas Company and Peoples Gas System's excusal from the prehearing and hearing in this docket, 13 which will be included in the draft -- in the final 14 Prehearing Order. 15 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Ms. Corbari, are there 16 17 any other matters to be addressed at this conference? 18 MS.
