## PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Good afternoon. Thank

you all for being so patient. And today is October 8th,

2014, roughly around 1:30. This is the 2014 clause

prehearing conferences for the following dockets:

140002-EG, 140003-GU, 140004-GU, 140007-EI, and

140001-EI. I would like to call this prehearing to

order.

Staff, can you please read the notice for this proceeding.

MS. TAN: By notice issued September 17th, 2014, this time and place is set for a prehearing conference in the following dockets: 140001-EI, 140002-EG, 140003-GU, 140004-GU, and 140007-EI. The purpose of the prehearing conference is set out in the notice.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you so much.

There are five dockets to address today.

Staff suggests that appearances be taken up all at once, so all parties should enter their appearances and declare the dockets that they are entering an appearance for, although I do recognize that several parties will be making appearances for more than one docket.

After the parties have made their appearances, staff will make their appearance as a whole. Starting

with my left, Mr. Butler.

MR. BUTLER: Thank you, Commissioner. For FPL -- excuse me -- John Butler, Wade Litchfield, and Maria Moncada in the 01 docket. Appearance for John Butler, Ken Rubin in the 02 docket, and John Butler, Wade Litchfield, and Maria Moncada in the 07 docket. Thank you.

**COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Okay.

MR. BEASLEY: Good afternoon, Commissioner.

Also I am appearing, Mr. LaVia and I are appearing in the energy conservation cost recovery docket on behalf of Wal-Mart Stores East and Sam's East. Thank you.

MR. CAVROS: Good afternoon, Commissioner.

George Cavros on behalf of the Southern

Alliance for Clean Energy, and I will be representing

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you for being here. 1 And now staff. 2 3 MS. TAN: Lee Eng Tan on behalf of the 02 docket, Kyesha Mapp and Keino Young on the 03 docket, 4 Kelley Corbari on the 04 docket, Charles Murphy on the 5 07 docket, and Martha Barrera on the 01 docket. Thank 6 7 you. COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you so much. 8 9 Mary Anne. 10 MS. HELTON: And Mary Anne Helton, I'm here as your advisor in all the dockets. 11 12 13 COMMISSIONER BROWN: We're going to move to 14 the 03 docket. This will convene the 140003 docket in the 2014 clause proceedings. 15 Mr. Keino Young, at this point are there any 16 17 preliminary matters? 18 MR. YOUNG: At this point there are none and 19 none are expected, Madam Commissioner. COMMISSIONER BROWN: Uh-huh. 20 21 MR. YOUNG: Staff would note that, for the 22 record that St. Joe Natural Gas Company and Peoples Gas 23 Systems, Incorporated, have been excused from this 24 prehearing and hearing in the 03 and the 04 docket. 25 staff would note that the parties, that the parties and

5	we're going to move even swifter through this one.

9	Section III, jurisdiction.		
10	Section IV, procedure for handling		
11	confidential information.		
12	Again, please jump in if you have any changes.		
13	Section V, prefiled testimony and exhibits and		
14	witnesses.		
15	Section VI, the order of witnesses. Staff.		
16	MR. YOUNG: Staff notes that the witnesses may		
17	be excused if the Commissioner seeks cross if no		
18	Commissioner seeks cross-examination. At this time it		
19	appears that all witnesses can be excused, but staff		
20	will confirm with each Commissioner and contact the		
21	parties as soon as possible.		
22	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Section VII, basic		
23	positions.		
24	MS. CHRISTENSEN: Commissioner, Patty		
25	Christensen with the Office of Public Counsel. We would		

change our position to none.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: None. Not no position, just none?

MS. CHRISTENSEN: It reads none at this time, and we'd just say none, period.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.

Noted?

MR. YOUNG: Duly noted.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Any other?

Section VIII, issues and positions.

Mr. Young.

MR. YOUNG: As stated, Commissioner, the parties and staff are proposing stipulation on all issues as reflected in the issues in Section -- issues and stipulation section of the draft Prehearing Order, which is Section VIII. Also, staff notes that the Order Establishing Procedure requires that the parties take a position at the prehearing conference unless good cause is shown as to why the party cannot take a position at this time.

Accordingly, if a party's position in the draft Prehearing Order is currently no position at this time, the parties must change their position or show good cause why it cannot take a position.

MS. CHRISTENSEN: Patty Christensen for the

Office of Public Counsel. We are changing our positions
from no position at this time to no position. And as
indicated in the earlier docket, by taking no position,
we are amenable to a Type 2 stipulation when we take no
position on the stipulation, taking ourselves out of

that.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. Duly noted.

Any others? Further, Mr. Young?

MR. YOUNG: For the record, staff recommends that to the extent that the parties here to take no position or wish to change their position be allowed to submit their position in writing no later than close of business tomorrow, October 9th. If the party fails to take a position by the time, by that time, the Prehearing Order will reflect no position for that party on, for such issues.

**COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Great. Thank you. Moving along. Section IX, exhibit list.

MR. YOUNG: Staff notes that it's prepared a draft comprehensive exhibit list which includes all prefiled exhibits. Staff will check with the parties prior to the hearing to determine if there are any objections to the Comprehensive Exhibit List.

COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Moving along, Section X, proposed stipulations.

MR. YOUNG: As stated, at this time it appears 1 that there are proposed stipulations on all issues, 2 3 knowing that OPC has taken no position on all the issues. 4 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Section XI, 5 pending motions. 6 7 MR. YOUNG: There are no pending motions. COMMISSIONER BROWN: XTT. 8 9 MR. YOUNG: There are no pending confidentialities. 10 11 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you for that. 12 Section XIII. MR. YOUNG: If the parties agree to waive 13 briefs, the Commission may make a bench decision for 14 this portion of the docket. If there is a -- if there 15 16 are any briefs, staff recommends that post-hearing 17 briefs be no longer than 20 pages. 18 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. 19 Section XIV, rulings. 20 MR. YOUNG: Staff recommends that opening 21 statements, if any, shall be limited to five minutes per 22 party, unless the party chooses to waive opening 23 statements. 24 **COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Okay. Yes. 25 MR. YOUNG: If we can go back to the Section

1	XIII, post-hearing procedures.
2	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Go ahead.
3	MR. YOUNG: Staff notes that the briefs will
4	be due November 5th for the December 16th, 2014, agenda
5	conference.
6	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Okay. Go back to
7	rulings.
8	MR. YOUNG: Staff notes that St. Joe, St. Joe
9	Natural Gas Company and Peoples Gas System are excused
10	from the prehearing and the hearing in this docket and
11	will be included in the draft Prehearing Order.
12	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Young.
13	Any other matters?
14	MR. YOUNG: There is none that staff is aware
15	of.
16	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Excellent work. This
17	docket is adjourned, unless any of the parties have
18	anything else to add. Thank you.
