AT&T FLORIDA’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (“AT&T Florida”), pursuant to Rule 28.106-204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Motion for Extension of Time to serve its Responses to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission’s First Set of Interrogatories and First Request for Production of Documents. In support, AT&T Florida states:

1. The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission served its First Set of Interrogatories on January 9, 2015, consisting of 76 Interrogatories and 2 Requests for Production of Documents.
