

# Proctor faces 3 misdemeanors

Zephyrhills official says he never sold the items in question

ZEPHYRHILLS — City Councilman Charlie Proctor faces three misdemeanor charges that he illegally bought and sold jewelry and other second-hand items from his coin shop, Charlie's Coins.

Proctor said he wasn't aware of the state laws governing the

sales of secondary goods, since he mostly deals in coins.

"I've been in business 25 years," he said. "I may not be the smartest man in the world, but I would never have broken the law over a \$6 certificate. That's what it costs to register."

Florida doesn't regulate the sale of U.S. coins, but anyone who deals in "secondary goods" including fine jewelry must register with the state Department of Revenue and comply with regulations on the sale of those items.

Pasco sheriff's Detective James

Prack, who inspected the shop last October, said Proctor failed to register and didn't properly document the transactions. He also violated the statutory rules that said jewelry items must be put on hold for 15 days before they can be resold, the report said.

Proctor said he never actually sold the items in question — two gold rings and a Springfield rifle — but he did have them in dis-

play cases at the store. He was selling them on consignment, according to the report. Proctor immediately filed the paperwork and received his secondary dealer certificate Nov. 6.

He said he never heard back from the sheriff's office and only learned this week from a television reporter that the State Attorney's Office had decided to prosecute him on the charges. The maximum penalty for each violation is \$10,000.

"It seems odd to me that this came up now that I have an elec-

tion coming up," Proctor said. "I haven't even seen the charges but the reporter already had them."

Proctor was first elected in 2011, defeating incumbent Councilman Manny Funes. He was unopposed in his re-election campaign until Monday, when Dylan Kinsman filed to run against him. Kinsman had initially filed to run against Councilman Kent Compton but withdrew from that race to challenge Proctor instead.

"In our home country, slavery and Jim Crow all too often was justified in the name of Christ."

DADE CITY — Joking that he has never traveled north of Lacochee, 81-year-old Wilbur Dew stood inside The Syrup Shack at the Pioneer Florida Museum and Village and lauded the variety of syrups. They've been locally produced for decades with homegrown sugar cane.

Sometimes the syrup comes out sweet; other times it's milder, said Dew, who will be among a handful of local syrup-makers giving demonstrations Saturday at the museum's 25th annual Farm Festival & Quilt Show.

Any way it comes out, the

syrup produced in east Pasco County is not to be confused with store-bought products such as Aunt Jemima.


"You can look at the label," said Dew, who was introduced to the syrup-making process when he was a child. "That (store-bought) stuff has corn syrup in it."

The local stuff, he said, is just syrup.

"In the old days, you used it for all of your sweeteners, in coffee or for a colicky baby — you'd just put it in their water," Dew said. "It was the standard sweetener, and you didn't have to go to the store to get it."

The process of transforming raw sugar cane into syrup

# Settlement ends strife over future of tiny road

Pompanic Street will be rebuilt, with drainage added

ST. LEO — The towns of San Antonio and St. Leo have reached a settlement and road improvement agreement to avoid a trial over Saint Leo University's use of tiny Pompanic Street, ownership of which is shared by the two municipalities.

San Antonio initiated a lawsuit last year over concerns about possible adverse effects to Pompanic caused by trucks accessing a proposed 17,000-square-foot plant operations facility that the university plans to build just off State Road 52.

During months of sometimes tense negotiations with the university, residents of both towns also expressed concerns about safety and property values.

Under the agreement reached last week, Pompanic, which "currently has substandard pavement and width," will be rebuilt from the intersection at S.R. 52 south to McMullen Drive. The rebuilt road will include two 12-foot-wide lanes and drainage.

St. Leo will pay no more than \$94,500 for the road improvements, which could cost more than twice that amount; under the agreement, the university
