Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 01677-15

On March 26, 2015, Peoples Gas System (PGS) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 01677-15. This document is the first amendment to a gas transportation agreement between PGS and Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. The information in the document for which PGS seeks confidential treatment relates to the maximum daily delivery quantity (MDQ), the monthly reservation charge, usage charges for quantities in excess of the MDQ, and incremental cost of service information. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with PGS that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of PGS.

Therefore, staff recommends that the request by PGS for confidential classification of Document No. 01677-15 be approved.
