Dear Commission Clerk,

As a follow up to the letter submitted by Brevard Waterworks, Inc. (BWW) in response to the OPC letter of concern, staff has requested the supporting revised calculations for the Outside Contractual Services for the U.S. Water Services Corporation contract. BWW pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006(3), Florida Administrative Code, requests confidential classification of its response.

The information being requested is "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 367.093(3), F.S. This requested information at issues relates to contractual data, such as operations and contract terms, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of U.S. Water Services (a non-regulated corporation) to negotiate contractual services contracts on favorable terms. The information at issue relates to the competitive interests of U.S. Water Services and its clients, the disclosure of which would impair their competitive businesses. Accordingly, such information constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" which is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act pursuant to Section 367.093(1), F.S.

This information should be considered proprietary confidential information in that is (i) intended to be and is treated as private, confidential information by the U.S. Water Services, (ii) because disclosure of the information would cause irreparable harm to U.S. Water Services' business operation, and (iii) the information has not been voluntarily disclosed to the public.

Wherefore, BWW respectfully request that the requested third party contracts be granted confidential classification and treated accordingly. The above utilities request that the information be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. that, the information remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in Section 366.093(4), F.S., and that the information be returned as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.
