You just send the request to "Records Clerk" (clerk@psc.state.fl.us), like you did below, advise what docket you wish to be included as an interested person in, and provide any relevant contact information.

Our system is set up to send documents by e-mail first. If that method fails (server down, e-mail address has changed, etc.) the system automatically asks if the information is to be faxed. If no fax number is available, the system asks if you would like the documents to be mailed by USPS.

Per your request below, you have been added with an e-mail address of sg7766@att.com. If you would like a fax number or mailing address to be included, please provide those to Records Clerk and we will update that information. Please note that this contact information is public record and will be available on internet searches. If you have any changes or wish to have your information removed, you should also forward those requests to Records Clerk.
