Please accept this letter as our response to your questions in the letter on June 26, 2015.

5. As discussed earlier, that plan has changed. Service would be provided upon execution of the standard customer service agreement and construction by the owner of the facilities needed to connect for service.

10. Volusia County approached NPUC to provide service Volusia County can't. They agreed to this certificate expansion to accomplish the goal of serving Capri Drive. Thereafter it can be done as needed.

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11. Volusia County inquired about NPUC serving the remote Pelican Dunes package plant just north of NPUC plant. These discussions are on hold awaiting the FPSC certification decision.

Ormond Beach stated that, if sometime in the future, NPUC wishes to interconnect with their system on the south on A1A and John Anderson DR. and decommission the sub-regional plant, they would have the capacity available now and probably (not guaranteed) have capacity far into the future.

Also, be advised that the reference to (the CIAC and new wastewater line extension charge) was taken off the application after our last meeting.

Have included a new map showing immediate service areas and future service areas. This map is consistent with our prior discussion with staff and our previous filings on this docket.
