Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 06832-15

On October 26, 2015, SeaCoast Gas Transmission, L.L.C. (SeaCoast) and Peoples Gas System (Peoples) filed a joint request for confidential classification for Document No. 06832-15. This document consists of the companies' responses to Commission staff's First Data Request in the subject docket. The information in the document for which SeaCoast and Peoples seek confidential treatment relates to: the estimated costs to construct the facilities required to deliver natural gas to an interconnect with Peoples, the level of a rate to be charged by SeaCoast to Peoples under the Transport Agreement, and the annual expense to Peoples of the charges payable by Peoples under the Transport Agreement with SeaCoast. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with SeaCoast and Peoples that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of SeaCoast and Peoples.

Therefore, staff recommends that the joint request by SeaCoast and Peoples for confidential classification of Document No. 06832-15 be approved.
