Issue 1: Should the Commission approve Tampa Electric Company’s petition for approval of a new environmental program for cost recovery through the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause?

On 1/26/16, TECO filed an amendment to its original petition in the above mentioned item. Therefore, staff is requesting to make oral modifications to the staff recommendation as described below in type/strike format.

On **page 3**, the last sentence of the recommendation paragraph should read as follows:

“Staff recommends that, as requested by TECO and consistent with approved similar programs for other IOUs, the capital costs associated with this new environmental program be allocated to rate classes on a demand basis and the O&M costs be allocated on an energy basis.”
