Dear Mr. Hillman:

This letter serves as written acknowledgement of continued discussions regarding transfer of ownership of the wastewater gravity line along Capri Drive and three existing lift stations along John Anderson Drive. The transfer of County owned wastewater infrastructure to the North Peninsula Utilities Corporation (NPUC) would facilitate the connection of residential properties along Capri Drive to a central sanitary sewer system.

While terms of an agreement have yet to be finalized, it is acknowledged that the County will consider transferring ownership of the wastewater infrastructure to NPUC. In turn, NPUC will connect the gravity line to its system and assume operations and maintenance for the collection system and lift stations.

The County utility does not seek to financially benefit from this potential arrangement. Nor does it seek to subsidize any project to the detriment of its current utility customers. The County seeks an agreement for the mutual benefit of our respective utilities which will enable more residents on the peninsula to receive reliable and safe sanitary sewer service.

I look forward to working with you in order to achieve these objectives.
