CITIZENS' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO MODIFY TESTIMONY FILING DATES

The Citizens of the State of Florida (Citizens), hereby file their Motion to Modify Testimony Filing Dates, and as grounds state the following:

1. By Order No. PSC-16-0105-PCO-EI, issued March 11, 2016, Order Establishing Procedure (OEP), the controlling dates that Citizens seek to modify were established as follows: Intervenors' testimony and exhibits due June 8, 2016; Staff's testimony and exhibits, if any, due June 13, 2016; and Rebuttal testimony and exhibits due June 22, 2016. The Prehearing Statement and Prehearing are scheduled for June 30, 2016 and July 19, 2016, respectively, and will be unaffected by Citizens request.
2. Citizens' Counsel will be out of town the week prior to Intervenor's due date and will not return until June 8, 2016. Further, the additional time will facilitate the Citizens' ability to present a fully vetted case to the Commission.
3. Therefore, Citizens seek to move the testimony filing dates back three days: Intervenors' testimony and exhibits due June 13, 2016; Staff's testimony and exhibits, if any, due June 16, 2016; and Rebuttal testimony and exhibits due June 27, 2016.
4. Citizens' Counsel conferred with the Parties to this matter. FPL has no objection to the Motion since the request is to move all testimony filing dates back three days. Counsels for Duke Energy, City of Miami, Florida Industrial Power User Group, PCS Phosphate, and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy have no objection to the Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens hereby request that the Commission grant their
Unopposed Motion to Modify Testimony Filing Dates.
