My wife and I have been residents of Indian River Shores for the past 28 years and over that time we have purchased our power requirements from Vero Beach under a very unfavorable contract that required us to pay a 30%% premium over FPL pricing. Fortunately, that contract expires in November, 2016.

Vero Beach is attempting to hold us and other Indian River Shores residents captive in perpetuity even though they no longer generate any electricity--they would simply resell power purchased at wholesale to us at a confiscatory pricing.

This approach is in total violation of the free market principles that have made the U.S. economy the greatest in the world and it should not stand!

I hope the Commission frees Indian River Shores at the contract expiration to purchase electricity from the most economic and reliable supplier thereby rewarding our residents and FPL who have worked hard to become the lowest cost and most reliable supplier.
