My wife and I have been residents of Indian River Shores for the past 28 years and over that time we have purchased electricity from Vero Beach at a 30% premium over FPL pricing. Fortunately, that contract expires in November, 2016.

Vero Beach is attempting to hold us and other Indian River Shores residents captive in perpetuity even though they no longer generate electricity but purchase it at wholesale to resell to us at confiscatory pricing.
