As homeowners and residents of Indian River Shores, we are paying more than a 30% premium for electric power provided by the City of Vero Beach, compared to rates being offered by FPL. Furthermore, we understand Vero Beach Utilities does not offer conservation plans or discounts on new appliances, as offered by FPL.

As a residents of Indian River Shores, we do not have representation in the decision making of this City owned utility and we do not benefit when the City uses utility profits, derived in part from the above-market electric rates we pay, to fund spending within the City of Vero Beach. In effect, we are subsidizing the operations of a City that is not accountable to us.

We ask that you approve the Indian River Shores petition to modify the territorial order, to permit FPL to provide electric power to Indian River Shores. We have a vested interest in this petition (Docket #160049) and formally request
