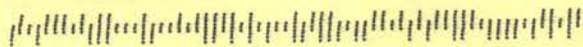
CONSUMER COMMENTS

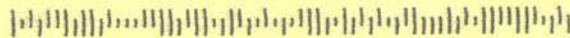
