BACKGROUND

Bocilla Utilities, Inc. (the "Utility") is a water utility whose offices are located at 7025-A Placida Road, Englewood, Florida 34224. The Utility's water facilities are located in Charlotte County, Florida.

On May 24, 2016, the Utility filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for an increase in its water rates to its customers in Charlotte County based on an historical test year ending December 31, 2015. Final rates and interim rates are based upon the same test year. The application is assigned Docket No. 160065-WU and July 19, 2016 was established as the official date of filing.

The Utility is requesting a rate increase because the existing rates do not provide sufficient revenues to cover the required expenses of operations on a going-forward basis and an opportunity to earn a fair return on the Utility's investment in used and useful property for the public use. The rate of return on equity requested in this proceeding is 10.5%. The overall rate of return requested is 5.92%. According to the Utility's books, Bocilla Utilities, Inc. states that its adjusted current overall rate of return without a rate increase is a negative 4.08%. This is the Utility's first rate filing since it has been in operation.

The Utility has incurred substantial additional operating costs and capital investment. Copies of the MFRs, the Rate Case Synopsis, and the Utility's application will be available for inspection at the following location:

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The test period for setting rates is the historical period ended December 31, 2015.

INTERIM RATES

On August 9, 2016, the Florida Public Service Commission approved an interim water rate increases for Bocilla Utilities, Inc. The interim rates will be effective August 31, 2016. The interim rates will be collected subject to refund, pending the Florida Public Service Commission's final decision regarding final rates. If a refund is ordered, it will include interest based upon Commission determined factors.

The current water rates, the Utility's requested interim water rates, the Utility's requested final water and the Commission approved interim water rates are set forth below. The final water rates are subject to change based on information gathered at the customer meeting, further Staff review, and the final decision by the Commissioners.
