


The increase in cost for pole installation and removal is a result of multiple business changes to include Labor Rates...

FPL OH Labor Rates

- With minor influx there is a stable increase in wage averaging ~\$5 a year
 - FPL OH Labor Rate increased ~\$81 from 2001 2015
 - Contractor OH Labor Rate increased ~\$54 from 2001 2015

Historical Labor Rates FPL & Contractor






A change in inventory practices increasing MOT Job Cost...

MOT Job Cost Increase

- Due to an change of inventory practices in 2015 we now align with the action of the asset being installed
 - Before the change 2 units installed (one for install one for scrap)
 - Now after the change 1 unit install and 1 unit scrap

MOT Job Cost Increase




In the past we inventoried all MOT as install decreasing the cost per job

We are removing more concrete poles now than in the past. The time required for cutting concrete poles is 10x longer.



An increase in Labor unit cost for large pole removal...

The labor cost has more than doubled



Bringing us to our current installation and removal costs.

Current Costs by Pole Type

| | Wood Poles | Concrete Poles |
|--------------|------------|----------------|
| Installation | ~\$1242 | ~\$4005 |
| Removal | ~\$552 | ~\$1730 |
| Replacement | ~\$2583 | ~\$6523 |

Replacement cost includes install and scrap PLUS all transferring of conductors (primary, secondary and service) . These transfers are not included on install or remove.
