





As president of TNE Telephone, Inc., Thomas Hadden brings more than twenty-one years' experience in designing, developing and marketing Telecommunications, VoIP, wide-area networking and storage management products.

Prior to starting TNE Telephone, Inc. Mr. Hadden serves as Chairman of the Board and CEO for Tandem Telephone, Inc. A Georgia based CLEC, Kinloch Telephone, Inc. A Georgia based CLEC., Anderson Telephone, Inc. a South Carolina CLEC, and Carrboro Telephone, Inc. a North Carolina, CLEC. Mr. Hadden also co founded Vault Telephone, Inc, which is a wholesale Telecom solutions provider utilizing, offering VoIP, SS7, SMS/800, LNP. TNE Telephone, Inc. has a Telecommunications Billing System capable of importing Call Detail Records from my different Telecommunication Switches, and exporting to standards such as EMI for export to Carrier Access Billing ("CABs")

During the 1999 to 2002 period Mr. Hadden served as the Chief Network officer for Universal Access "UAXS," which went public in 2000, as symbol UAXS.
