Thank you for allowing me to communicate with you via email. I question the fact the fact that Bocilla. Utility requests a price increase, not even

- a) If significant changes have to be made to secure the water supply then I would expect other utilities would have to increase their rate by about 40 % as well. That is not the case. If Bocilla was underfunded in the past years they would have and MUST have asked for an increase right then.
- b) Bocilla water is already quite expensive when compared to the utilities in the vicinity.

As these water suppliers hold a monopoly it is utmost important to compare and ensure that they do not take advantage of their monopoly. The other utilities do not lose money? I strongly recommend declining any drastic price increase.
