Pursuant to Section 367.156 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Gulf Power Company (Gulf) requested confidential classification of certain highlighted information on Document No. 00073-17, which is Gulf's response to staff's 8th set of Interrogatories (Nos. 328).

Staff reviewed Gulf's confidential request and agrees Document No. 00073-17 contains information that is part of confidential tax return deductions taken by Gulf for 2015 related to bonus depreciation. Gulf does not disclose this information to the public. Although Gulf submits this information to the IRS, it does so confidentially, the disclosure of which would adversely impact Gulf's competitive business interest. In staff opinion, Gulf's request meets criteria for confidentiality set forth in section 367.156, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information in the context in which it is presented in Document No. 00073-17 be approved.
