My name is Elizabeth Ann Roeslein and I receive service from Gulf Power at 524 Regatta Bay Blvd, Destin, FL 32541. I want to **protest** the Gulf Power petition with the Public Service Commission in October for a \$106.8 million increase.

My husband and I are not receiving increases in our pay that would compensate paying more money per month for electricity. I read that the current fixed charge per month is \$18 and will increase to \$48 per month. Below is a comparison of rates with other fixed charges around Florida. Please note how the proposed \$48.09 compares:

- a. Duke Energy \$8.76
- b. Florida Power & Light Co. \$7.87
- c. JEA (Jacksonville) \$5.50
- d. Tallahassee \$7.41
- e. Gulf Power \$48.09 (proposed)
