Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Gulf Power Company (GPC) requests confidential classification of certain information included in the testimony and exhibit (DMR-3) of witness Ramas.

GPC is claiming confidentiality of portions of the testimony and portions of exhibit DMR-3, under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes; "[I]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Section 366.093(3)(e) F.S. "[I]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

Staff has reviewed GPC's confidentiality request and in staff's opinion, the highlighted information, which includes information regarding allocation factors for affiliate transactions and results of a site specific geotechnical investigation for permitting activities, meet the definition of confidential business information under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the information contained in Document No. 01389-17 meets the criteria for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e) F.S.
