On December 5, 2016, Sunny Shores Water Company, Inc. notified Commission staff that its correct name is Sunny Shores Water Co., pursuant to the Florida Department of State's Division of Corporation's records (DN 09119-16). Also, although the utility provided its name as "Sunny Shores Water Co., Inc." in its application for a grandfather water certificate in Docket No. 960028-WS, the Florida Department of State's Division of Corporation's records appear to reflect that the utility's correct name was "Sunny Shores Water Co." at the time the Commission granted Water Certificate No. 578-WU to the utility by Order No. PSC-96-0599-FOF-WS.

Please amend the utility's information in the Commission's Case Management System so that the Commission's records reflect the utility's name as Sunny Shores Water Co.
