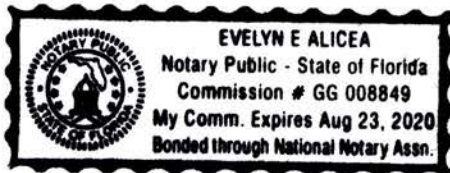

By Order No. PSC-17-0041-PAA-WU, in Docket No. 140177-WU, issued February 1, 2017, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved a phase II increase in water rates for Holiday Gardens Utilities, LLC. (utility). A schedule of Commission approved rates are set forth below.

The old charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle before the effective date of the new rates. The new charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle on or after the effective date of the new rates.
