- 2. Called USW utility billing indicating:
  - A. We have no pool.
  - B. We have no leak.
  - C. We have a sprinkler system that has not been turned on or used.
  - D. We were only at the billing address for one week of the period.

Therefore, impossible to use 81,000 gallons.

- 3. USW field agent checked the meter and said usage was impossible. He recommended changing the meter.
- Company billing rep said meter was correct and did not note recommendation of field agent.

New theory was that someone must have tapped in and stole 81,000 gallons.

- 5. These locations are either cement pads for RV's or Park Model homes
  - with no possible use for that much water.

I invite anyone to come to the site and explain this to me.
