Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), Gulf Power Company (GPC or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information produced in response to staff's third request for production of documents (specifically Nos. 14, 20, 21, 25, and 26) and staff's third set of interrogatories (specifically No. 97).

With regards to GPC's responses to staff's POD Nos. 14, 20, and 21, these documents contain information related to the transmissions system that could impact the competitive interests of the Company. In addition, staff notes that the maps included may also represent a security concern. Therefore, staff recommends that the information included in POD Nos. 14, 20, and 21 be deemed confidential pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(c) and (e), F.S.

With regard to GPC's responses to staff's PODs Nos. 25 and 26, these documents contain information related to the economic model for demand-response programs that could impact the competitive interests of the Company. Therefore, staff recommends that the information included in PODs 25 and 26 be deemed confidential pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.

With regard to GPC's response to staff's interrogatories 97, these documents contain information related to assets owned by the Company that could impact bids or other contractual data and could have an impact on the competitive interests of the Company. Therefore, staff recommends that the information included in interrogatories 97 be deemed confidential pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S.

Staff has reviewed the documents included in response to its third request for production of documents and third set of interrogatories, and in staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(c), (d), and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 09261-16 be approved.

Staff also notes that these items were inadvertently not included along with prior memoranda of confidentiality for the docket. Furthermore, Order No. PSC-17-0190-CFO-EI was issued on May 18, 2017, prior to the filing of this memorandum.
