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2 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Now we're going to take up
3 Items 8 through 12 together, so if you can introduce
4 them all together.

5 **MR. SHAFER:** Madam Chair and Commissioners, I
6 just wanted to take a moment to acknowledge that this is
7 Don Rome's final agenda with the Commission. He'll be,
8 sadly for us, retiring at the end of the month, and we
9 just wanted to take a moment to recognize his
10 contribution to our division and to the Commission as a
11 whole.

12 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Thank you, Greg.

13 Mr. Rome, you've done such a great job over
14 the years, and you're an invaluable staff member here.
15 I personally appreciate all the work that you've done
16 here.

17 **MR. ROME:** Thank you.

18 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** What are you going to be
19 doing? Retiring?

20 **MR. ROME:** Yes. In a word, yes.

21 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Well, you will be missed.

13 correspondence or complaints. Staff recommends approval
14 of all five items and is available to answer questions.

18 items.
