Thank you for contacting the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC). We appreciate your comments about Florida Public Utilities Company's (FPUC) limited proceeding request for a rate change.

To give Commissioners and staff an opportunity to review your concerns, your correspondence is included in the file for Docket No. 20170150-EI. All customer correspondence will be reviewed and considered when PSC staff prepares its recommendation to the Commissioners on FPUC's request.

The PSC is expected to consider FPUC's request before the end of this year. Commissioners will examine FPUC's need for its request, and its ability to provide safe and reliable service. FPUC has requested its proposed rate adjustment begin in January 2018.

Commissioners are charged with making sure that Florida's utility companies fulfill their service obligation. The PSC will ensure that final customer rates reflect only those costs that are prudent and necessary for FPUC to deliver quality electric service to your home or business.
