

TO CUSTOMERS OF MCLEOD GARDENS UTILITIES, LLC

By Order No. PSC-2017-0367-PAA-WU, in Docket No. 20160193-WU, issued September 29, 2017, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved non-sufficient funds (NSF) charges. The Commission also approved a meter tampering charge, which may be levied when an investigation reveals evidence of meter tampering. The charge is designed to cover the cost of a service representative making a special premises visit to determine if there is evidence of tampering of the meter. A schedule of Commission approved charges are set forth below.

Non-Sufficient Funds Charges (NSF)

Pursuant to Section 68.065, Florida Statutes the following NSF charges may be assessed:

- 1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50
- 2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300
- 3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300,
- 4) or five percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater

Meter Tampering Charge
\$50.00

The rates shall be effective for service rendered on or after the Commission's stamped approval date on the tariff sheets provided the customers have received notice. If you have any questions, please call the utility at 863-904-5574.
