

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S  
STATUS REPORT ON TEMPORARY SERVICE**

Tampa Electric Company reports as follows regarding the status of the provision of temporary retail electric service by Tampa Electric and Peace River Electric Cooperative, Inc. to mining facilities located in each other's service areas:

1. As directed by Florida Public Service Commission Order No. PSC-12-0661-EU in Docket No. 120247-EU, this is a report regarding the status of the provision of temporary service to Mosaic at the end of the initial 5-year term of the variance agreement which that order approved.


2. Under that variance agreement, PRECO was permitted to provide electric service to Mosaic in the F1 mining area while Tampa Electric was permitted to provide electric service to Mosaic in the E20 mining area, which mining areas cross between the PRECO and Tampa Electric service territories.

3. Mining in the 20E area was completed in December 2015. However, mining in the F-1 area only began in August 2017 and is projected to continue through 2022 depending on mining permits. If permits are delayed, this schedule could accelerate, whereas if earlier, or if more draglines are operational sooner, it could extend out a couple of additional years.

4. Because the F1 area mining continues, both Tampa Electric and PRECO desire to continue the variance at least until the F1 area mining has concluded. The parties will notify the Commission at the termination of the variance agreement.
