Good morning Sakina,

CenturyLink would like to request that the FPSC issue an email to NeuStar making a change to order PSC-2018-0071-CO-TL which was issued January 5, 2018 in Docket 20170250-TL.

I was advised yesterday (January 11, 2018) that there was an error on the initial request from the CenturyLink account team in their request for numbers for a specific customer in the Fort Myers area. The request for numbers should have been in BONITA SPG, FL Rate Center, not FORT MYERS, FL as originally submitted. Rita Schmitz with CenturyLink spoke with Dara Flowers from the Pooling Administration and she advised if the Waiver from the commission can be updated to reflect BONITA SPG with the switch CLLI of: BNSPFLXADSO, then CenturyLink can submit a Code Modification request and have the Rate Center and switch name updated to correct the request. Since the effective date of the Code has not been reached yet, we are able to request the correction without starting the process over. Since the effective date for the assigned Code is February 10, we may be able to minimize the delay for the customer by updating the current code assigned.

We regret this error in the original request and the extra work that is required by the FPSC staff and NeuStar. However, we would appreciate your assistance with this in order to be able to provide these numbers to the customer in a timely manner as they are moving into their new building soon.
