Thank you for your letter in which you expressed your concerns regarding the proposed customer deposit requested by Heather Hills Utilities, LLC. (Heather Hills or utility). To ensure that the Commission staff and the Commissioners have knowledge of your concerns, your letter has been placed on the correspondence side of the docket file for all to review.

We understand your concerns regarding Heather Hills' proposed customer deposits. The utility's request is for initial service and not for existing customers. Therefore, the requested customer deposits would not be applicable to your service. However, for existing customers with unsatisfactory payment records, by Rule 25-30.311(7), Florida Administrative Code, the utility may require, upon reasonable notice being separate and apart from any bills for service, a new deposit, where previously waived or returned, or an additional deposit, in order to secure payment of current bills.
